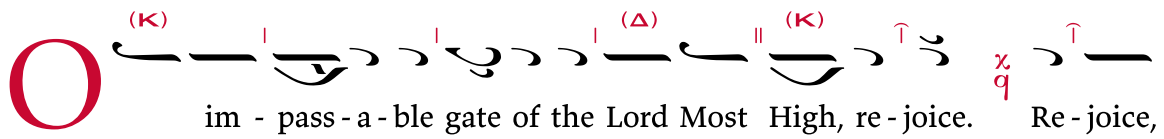

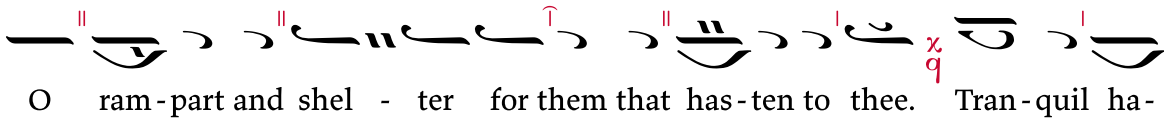

willed to res - ur - rect the dead.

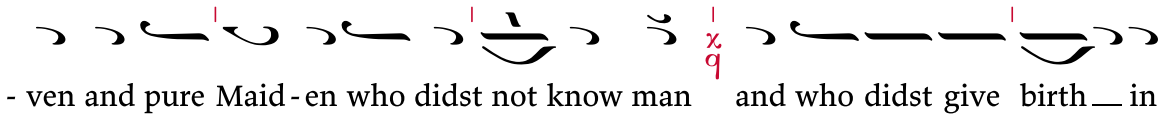
