

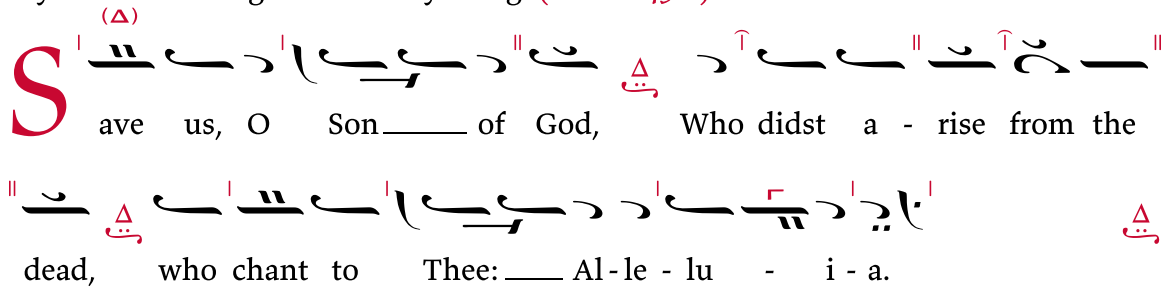

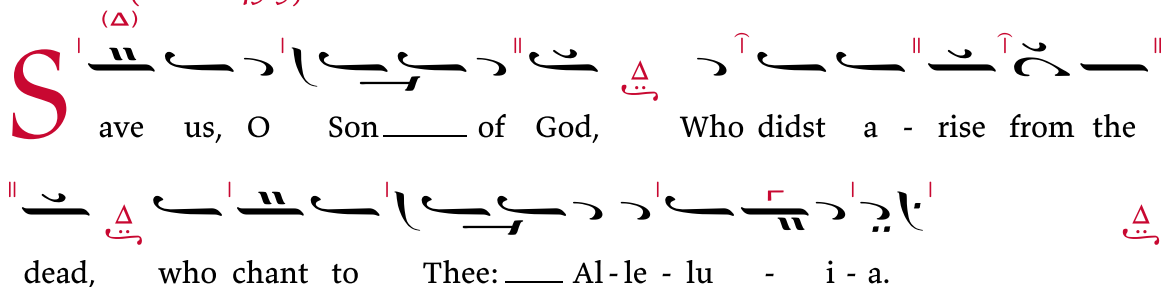

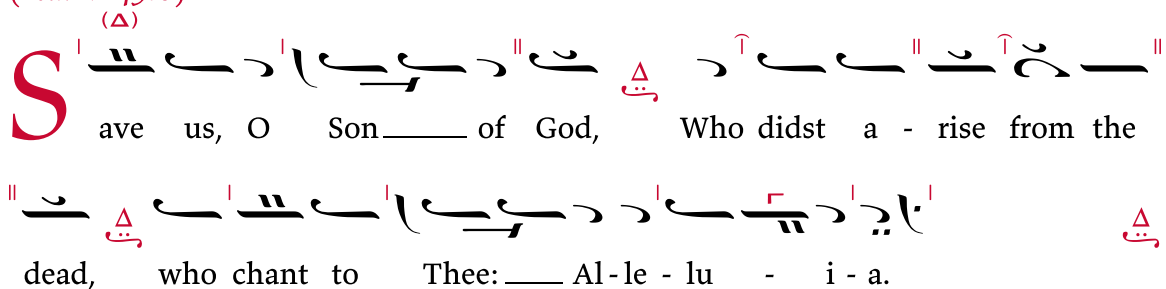
Verse: Praise the Lord, O my soul. I will praise the Lord in my life, I will chant unto my God for as long as I have my being. (*Psalms 145:1*)
